Please read the following carefully before completing the application form:

1. This scholarship is open to final year (Year 3 /Year 4) undergraduate students at UNM, with First Class Honours.
2. The applicant must meet the entry requirements of Ph.D. programmes of Nottingham.
3. Already registered on-going Ph.D. students are not eligible to apply under this scheme.
4. This scholarship will support waiving the full tuition fees for the 3 years of the Ph.D. programme.
5. This scholarship will not support any other research expenses (e.g., monthly stipend, equipment, consumables, travel for student and supervisor, etc.). So, it is important to ensure the availability of additional funding from the respective supervisors.
6. If you are aware of any such additional funding, please enter all the relevant details in the 'Additional Information' section of this application form.
7. Applicants should complete all the sections of this form. State "N/A" for the sections that do not apply to you.
8. Copies of all the relevant certificates, academic transcripts, brief curriculum vitae and/or other related documents (non-returnable) should be attached to this application.
9. Incomplete or late applications will **STRICTLY** not be accepted or considered for the next stage.
10. Successful candidates will be required to apply for admission into Ph.D. programmes immediately (September intake, 2022).

Terms and conditions

1. You are expected to create a minimum of **one scholarly** output per academic year which is eligible for submission in the MyRA report to the Ministry of Higher Education.
2. The scholarship is subjected to a satisfactory review of progression **on a yearly basis** for each academic year.
3. The scholarship will be terminated, with immediate effect, if you withdraw from your studies, fail to meet the progression requirements of UNM, transfer to a different degree course or University, or accept another scholarship offer.
4. It should be noted that the University has a strict policy regarding paid work within and outside of the University. As such, the scholarship is only offered to full-time PhD students. Any students who are currently in full-time employment or seeking a part-time job will be ineligible for the award.
