



Postgraduate Research Award for Contribution to the University's Research Community 2023

Guidance Note

This award is designed to recognise the contributions that postgraduate researchers have made to the University's research community during the period of January – December 2022.

In particular, this award is to celebrate exceptional contributions which would not be readily captured by student awards which might otherwise go unseen. This award excludes outputs which would typically be MyRA returnable.

For 'Section 2: Judging Criteria', examples of contributions could include (but not limited to):

- Activities which foster a positive and inclusive research culture
- Supporting the career development of others
- Contributing to research(er) innovations that impact beyond the immediate research group/area
- Contribution to open science
- Being an advocate or representative for their research(er) community
- Research-focused contributions to University outreach or voluntary activities

Deadline for nominations: 12noon, Friday 14 April 2023

A panel of judges will consider all submissions and recommend a list of award winners. A tri-campus award ceremony will take place on Wednesday 17 May 2023 in Malaysia and via video link with Nottingham campuses.
