The Policy Impact Award will be presented to a doctoral researcher who has been actively using their research to inform policy dialogues and influence public policy, through engaging with local or national government, or other relevant organisations such as charitable sector.

The Public Engagement with Research Award will be presented to a doctoral researcher or a team of doctoral researchers who have engaged a public audience(s) with their research to generate mutual benefit. Public engagement activity can range from outreach activities, to patient involvement, citizen science and collaborative research projects.

### **Deadline for nominations: 12noon, Friday 14 April 2023**

A panel of judges will consider all submissions and recommend a list of award winners. A tri-campus award ceremony will take place on Wednesday 17 May 2023 in Malaysia and via video link with Nottingham campuses.
