Applicants may support learning through a wide range of activities, including demonstrating in laboratory classes, distance learning, leading seminars or tutorials, supporting project work, assessing, development of resources, giving feedback on student work or welfare and support of other students. These awards are given to people who can show innovative and reflective practice by:

- Improving effectiveness in their support of learning
- Making appropriate changes in learning activities or techniques
- Evidence-informed evaluation and reflection on the impact of their intervention and possibilities for further development
