

UNM PhD High Achiever Scholarship

Application Notes

Please read the following carefully before completing the application form:

- 1. This scholarship opportunity is available to UNM students and students from other universities recognised by the Ministry of Higher Education Malaysia.
- 2. Applicants who are in their final year (Year 3/Year 4) of undergraduate studies, with First Class Honours, or are in the final semester of a Master's program, are eligible to apply.
- 3. The applicant must meet the entry requirements of PhD programmes of Nottingham.
- 4. Already registered on-going MPhil/PhD students are not eligible to apply under this scheme.
- 5. This scholarship will provide full tuition fee waiver and monthly stipend for a duration of 3 years, supporting students throughout the entirety of the PhD programme.
- 6. This scholarship will not support any other research expenses (e.g. consumables, travel for student and supervisor, etc.). So, it is important to ensure the availability of additional funding from the respective potential supervisors.
- 7. If you are aware of any such additional funding, please enter all the relevant details in the 'Additional Information' section of this application form.
- 8. Applicants should complete all the sections of this form. State "N/A" for the sections that do not apply to you.
- 9. Copies of all the relevant certificates, academic transcripts, brief curriculum vitae and/or other related documents (non-returnable) should be attached to this application.
- 10. Incomplete or late applications will **STRICTLY** not be accepted or considered for the next stage.
- 11. Successful candidates will be required to apply for admission into PhD programmes immediately (September intake, 2023).

- 1. You are **required** to publish a minimum of **two papers** (in the **top 10% of your research area** / in **Q1 of your research area**) during your PhD studies, which are eligible for submission in the MyRA report to the Ministry of Higher Education.
- 2. The UNM Scholarship is subjected to a satisfactory review of progression **on a yearly basis** for each academic year.
- 3. The scholarship will be terminated, with immediate effect, if you withdraw from your studies, fail to meet the progression requirements of UNM, transfer to a different degree course or University, or accept another scholarship offer.
- 4. It should be noted that the University has a strict policy regarding paid work within and outside of the University. As such, the UNM Scholarship is only offered to full-time PhD students. Any students who are currently in full-time employment or seeking a part-time job will be ineligible for the award.
